June 17-20 (Tuesday - Friday)

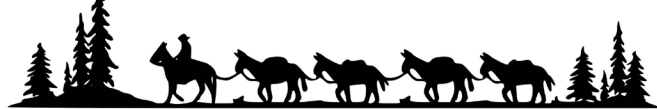
