# \*Message for Team Kennedy\*

Many of you are aware that Kennedy Corr was hospitalized on May 31, and spent 9 days in the hospital in Billings. We've since learned that Kennedy has a previously undiagnosed genetic condition, and while the long-term prognosis is optimistic, she's looking at anywhere from 3 months to a year before she's fully recovered. For the next few weeks (or more, we're not sure) she is mostly home-bound, and will be unable to work for the foreseeable future. Wendy is her primary caregiver, but has been blessed so far with help from family and friends who stay with her when Wendy can't be at home.

So many people have asked how they can help! For anyone who would like to assist the Corr girls, here are some options:

- Kennedy isn't eating much, but Walmart or Albertsons gift cards would be very appreciated. Additionally, they could also use some help with gas money, getting back and forth to appointments in Billings and in Cody (they live outside of town), and she's on a number of prescriptions. Any financial help would be welcome, especially as Kennedy won't be able to resume work for at least several weeks.
- Kennedy is both gluten and dairy intolerant, and sugar is not good for headaches. But if anyone wanted to make a batch of healthy muffins for an easy breakfast, or a pot of soup that doesn't have dairy or wheat ingredients, that would be wonderful!

Kennedy has received so many beautiful cards and flowers and thoughts and prayers, and she and Wendy and the rest of their family are beyond grateful! God's hand is present in all of this, and we are confident that His hand will guide her healing. Please continue to lift her up in prayer as she travels this long road to recovery.

## Gospel

Luke 5:17-26

<sup>17</sup> One day Jesus was teaching, and Pharisees and teachers of the law were sitting there. They had come from every village of Galilee and from Judea and Jerusalem. And the power of the Lord was with Jesus to heal the sick. <sup>18</sup> Some men came carrying a paralyzed man on a mat and tried to take him into the house to lay him before Jesus. 19 When they could not find a way to do this because of the crowd, they went up on the roof and lowered him on his mat through the tiles into the middle of the crowd, right in front of Jesus.

<sup>20</sup> When Jesus saw their faith, he said, "Friend, your sins are forgiven."

<sup>21</sup> The Pharisees and the teachers of the law began thinking to themselves, "Who is this fellow who speaks blasphemy? Who can forgive sins but God alone?"

They were filled with awe and said, "We have seen remarkable things today."
