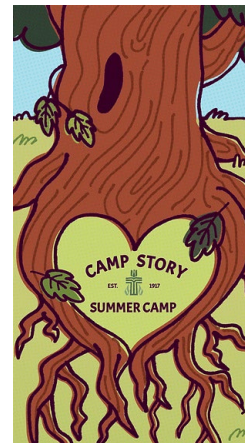
PW SCHOLARSHIPS
