The Worship committee will be taking orders on February 18th, 25th and March 3 to decorate the sanctuary for Easter.



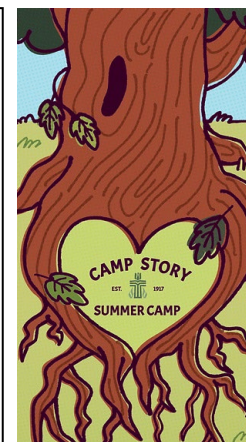
Choices will include hydrangeas and Easter lilies for \$20 and daffodils, tulips and hyacinth for \$15

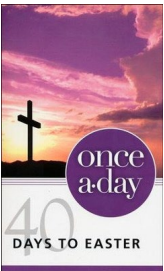
