### Revelation 21:1-8 (NIV)

#### A New Heaven and a New Earth

- <sup>1</sup> Then I saw "a new heaven and a new earth," for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea.
- <sup>2</sup>I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.
- <sup>3</sup> And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God.
- <sup>4</sup> 'He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."
- <sup>5</sup> He who was seated on the throne said, "I am making everything new!" Then he said, "Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true."
- <sup>6</sup> He said to me: "It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the thirsty I will give water without cost from the spring of the water of life.
- <sup>7</sup>Those who are victorious will inherit all this, and I will be their God and they will be my children.
- <sup>8</sup> But the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars—they will be consigned to the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death."

## **1 Corinthians 15:12-22 (NIV)**

#### The Resurrection of the Dead

- <sup>12</sup> But if it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?
- <sup>13</sup> If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised.
- <sup>14</sup> And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith.

- <sup>15</sup> More than that, we are then found to be false witnesses about God, for we have testified about God that he raised Christ from the dead. But he did not raise him if in fact the dead are not raised.
- <sup>16</sup> For if the dead are not raised, then Christ has not been raised either.
- <sup>17</sup> And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins.
- <sup>18</sup> Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ are lost.
- <sup>19</sup> If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied.
- <sup>20</sup> But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep.
- <sup>21</sup> For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man.
- <sup>22</sup> For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive.
