John the Baptist Prepares the Way

- ¹ In those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the wilderness of Judea
- ² and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."
- ³ This is he who was spoken of through the prophet Isaiah:
- "A voice of one calling in the wilderness,
- 'Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him."
- ⁴ John's clothes were made of camel's hair, and he had a leather belt around his waist. His food was locusts and wild honey.

- ¹¹ "I baptize you with-water for repentance. But after me comes one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with-the Holy Spirit and fire.
- ¹² His winnowing fork is in his hand, and he will clear his threshing floor, gathering his wheat into the barn and burning up the chaff with unquenchable fire.
